# Charles Novo, Jr. Memorial Scholarship



The Executive Board has approved the AME Scholarship Fund to award a \$500 scholarship, by lottery, to an AME member enrolled in any course of study.

This scholarship was established by the Union in 2007 to honor the memory of Charles Novo, Jr. who led the decertification move from the Civil Service Employees Association (CSEA) in 1984, which created AME, the largest independent Union in Suffolk County. In 1985, Novo was elected as the first President of AME and served in that position until 1991.

All applicants must be enrolled in programs at accredited institutions of higher learning, including BOCES, during the 2010 school year.

Applications will be available at AME Headquarters beginning Tuesday, June 1, 2010 by calling AME at 589-8400. All applications must be returned to AME Headquarters, 30 Orville Drive, Suite A, Bohemia, **no later than June 30, 2010.**
