## An Overwhelming Victory – 88% Chose AME!

AME members of the Suffolk County Community College Blue Collar Unit voted *overwhelmingly* to keep AME as their sole and exclusive bargaining agent and union representative covering their positions within Suffolk County employment.

The Public Employee Relations Board (PERB) reported 201 ballots were mailed out to SCCC Blue Collar AME members. Of the 163 ballots mailed back, 142 designated AME as the union of choice with 20 ballots cast for CSEA/other.

Suffolk County AME has always emphasized the vital importance of its independence; and now this important AME mantra has been significantly validated by its SCCC members! "We appreciate the confidence our members have clearly demonstrated for their union," said Cheryl Felice, AME President.

"As we followed through in the past when faced with decertification actions and/or threats, we welcome *all members* to reunite in *union solidarity* to be part of the greatest independent union in Suffolk County – AME," President Felice added.
